Restoration News in 2020

The Sutter Creek Community Benefit Foundation (SCCBF) is dedicated to the restoration, preservation, and development of Sutter Creek's historical assets and community culture.

The Foundation's initial focus has been on the development of Miners' Bend Park and the restoration of the Historic Sutter Creek Grammar School. Miners' Bend Park was completed in 2016.



The grammar school has been returned to public use

and has a new warming kitchen, refinished floors, and interior painting.



Seventeen new windows are waiting to be installed before the end of this year. The windows are UV resistant, dual-pane gas filled, and insulating. They will be placed in the entire 1871 west wing. There is also new insulation and a modern security and fire alarm system.



Looking toward next year:

- A grant to help pay for upgrading the HVAC system will be submitted;
- Work will continue on a community heritage project to be

housed in "Room 4". Keep an eye on "Room 4" for future updates!

- Three high school scholarships will be awarded to students with an appreciation for historic preservation; and
- Restoration of flag poles at the grammar school and Minnie Provis Park.

Longer term goals include painting of the grammar school's exterior and additional restoration projects within the community.

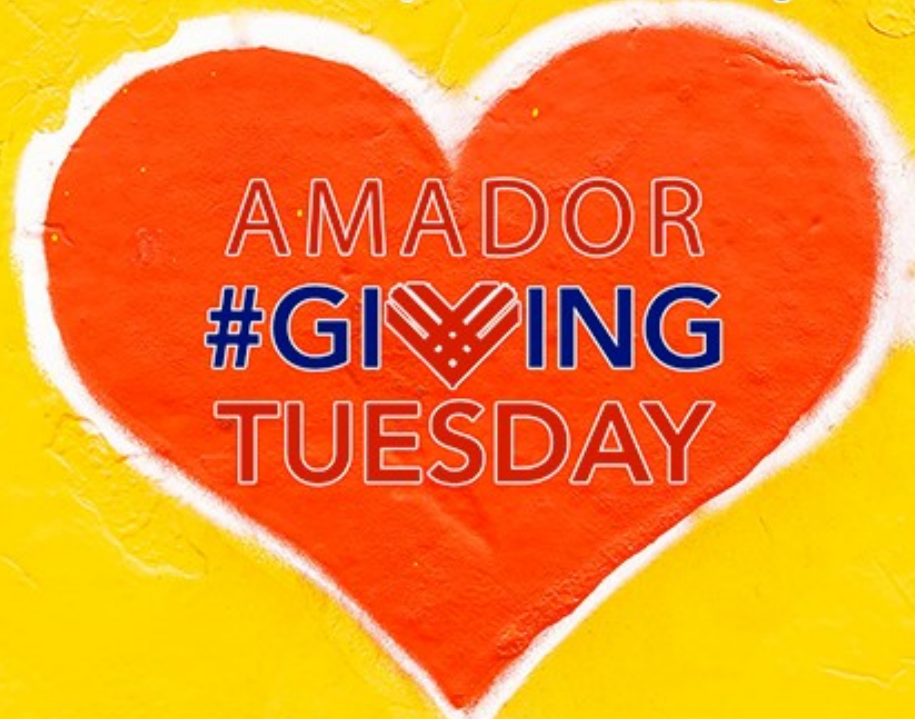
