Starting this month, we are kicking off the museum's Artifact Acquisition Program. You may have old objects and items gathering dust in a closet or attic that are just the right puzzle piece to complete a display or story that is waiting to be told. While not every item will fit the need, and some will be declined, if you have or know of artifacts that might relate to Sutter Creek and the surrounding community, we would love to hear from you. The restoration of the Grammar School and the development of the museum is an endeavor that can only move forward with the generous support of our community.


